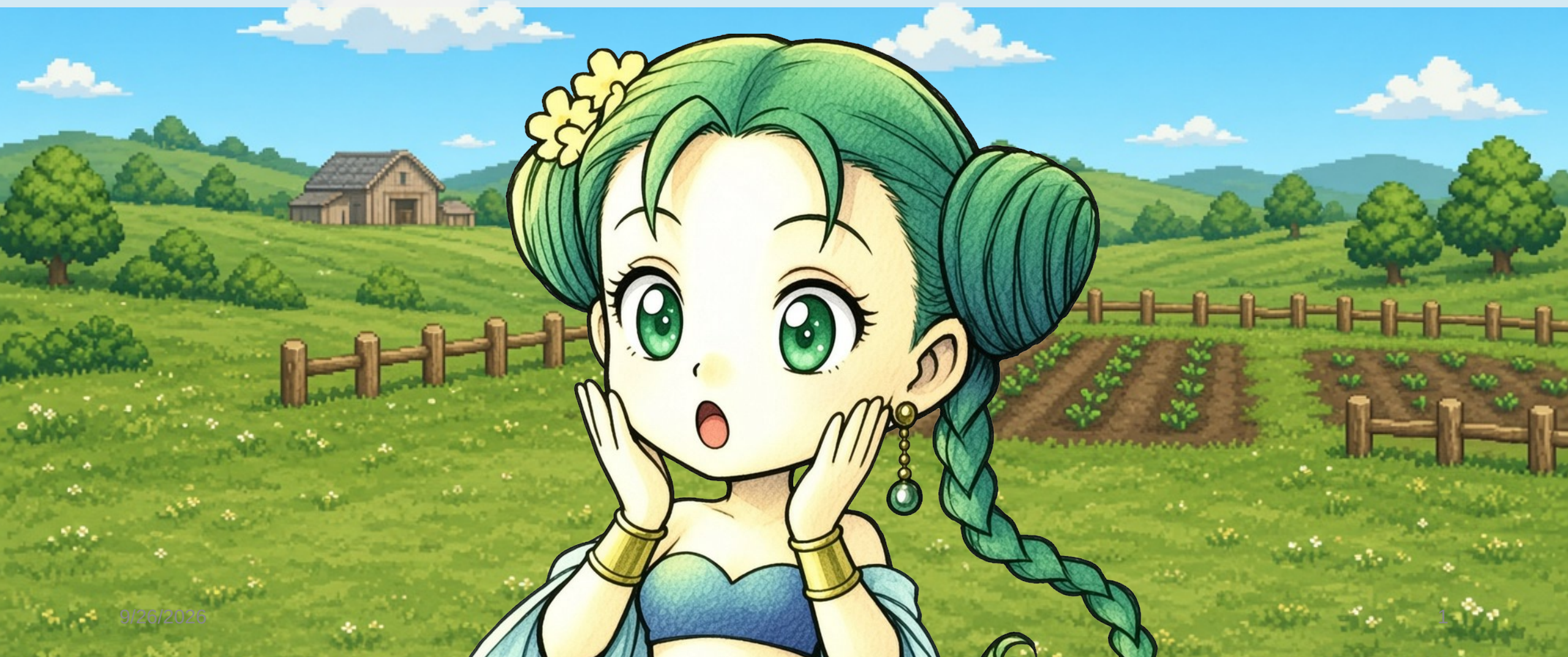


Courting the Harvest Goddess

How do you marry most bachelorettes?

Harvest Goddess is not like other women in this game. However, understanding the others is a good start to better understanding HG's needs:

Requirements for marriage in FoMT are:

Heart Level maxed; give gifts and talk to her often

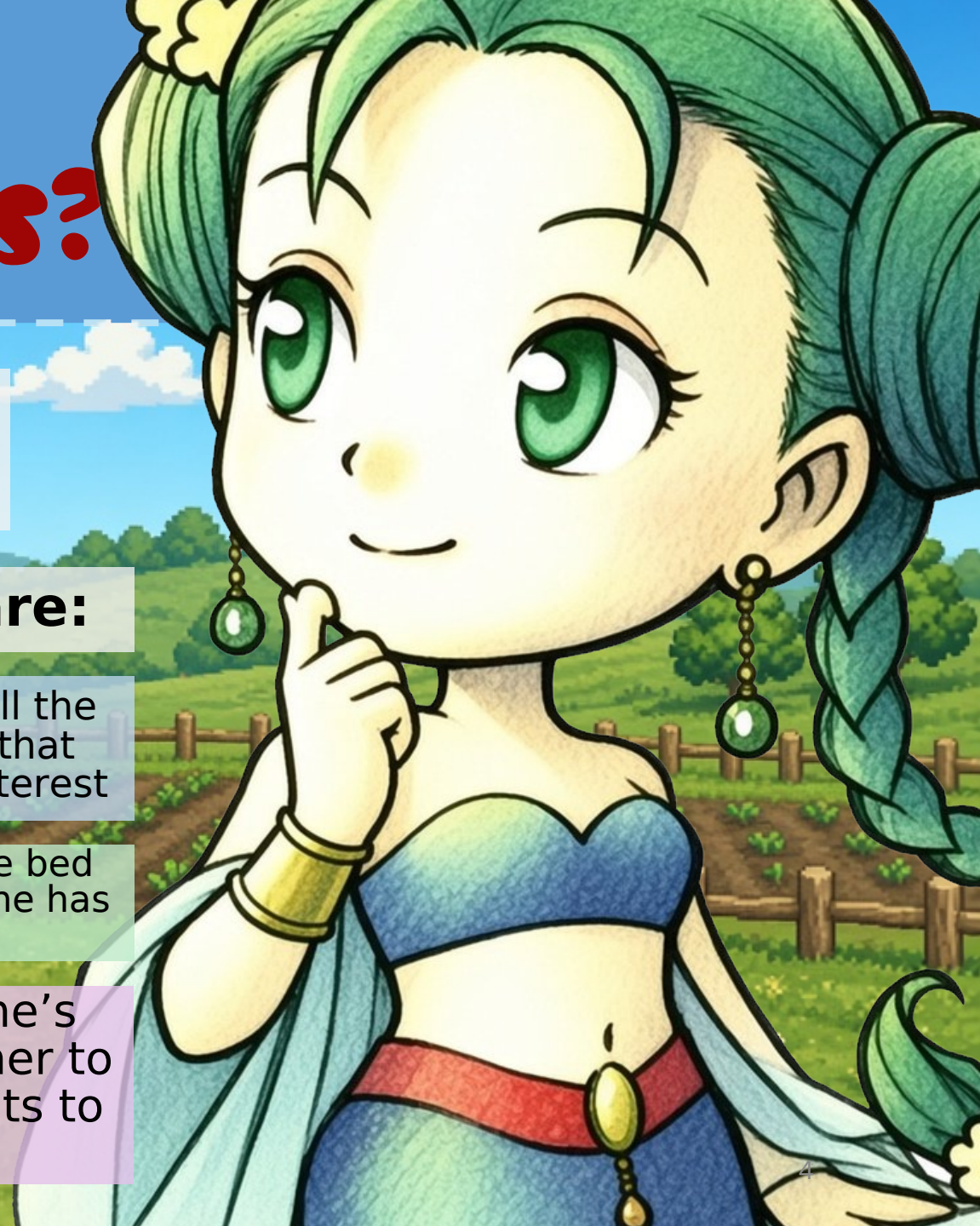
Heart Events; unlock all the visual novel cutscenes that favour you as the love interest

House Size; expand your house to the largest size available

Big Bed; Have the double bed furniture item crafted so she has a place to sleep

Propose with the Blue Feather; using the game's version of an engagement ring, give the Blue Feather to a bachelorette meeting the above four requirements to trigger the final Heart Event

HG only has one (1) common requirement with other bachelorettes. The rest are all new and unique to her.

How to Marry the Harvest Goddess:

Catch all the Fish; catch at least ONE of every variety of fish in the game **(There are 50);**

Collect all 9 Goddess Jewels; form the Goddess Gem with them;

Dig up all Lake Mine Items; Cursed Tools, all gems, and Kappa Gem;

Ship every item; sell at least ONE of every shippable item with a monetary trade value **(There are 103);**

Be in Year 5 or Later; barely a requirement because this all takes 5 in-game years to do and took 7 of my real-life years;

Dig up all Spring Mine Items; All metals, Teleport Stone, and French Fry Recipe;

Confess your Love for the Goddess to the Priest; Tell your pastor, Carter, that you are having thoughts about marrying the Goddess and ask him if he's OK with it. If he approves, then there's only one thing left to do...

Propose with the Blue Feather!



Spring Mine? Lake Mine?

In order to descend through the mines, you need the following three tools:

Hammer; for smashing the rocks in the mine;

Hoe; for digging in the soil to find items and exits;

Fishing Rod; for fishing up 1 of the 6 King Fish;

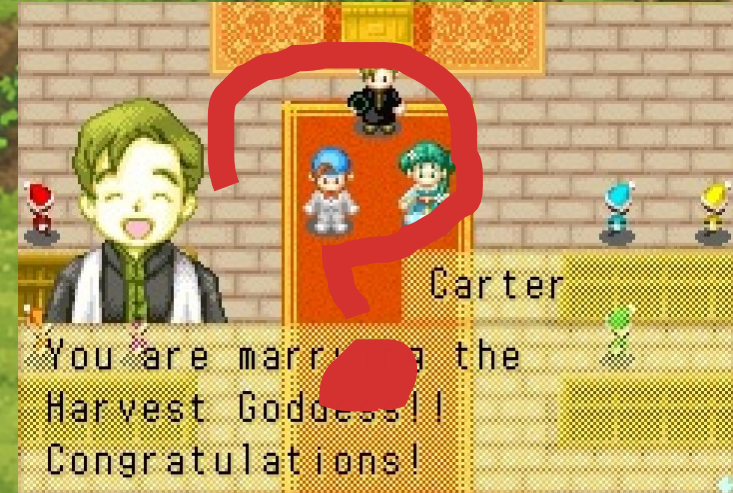
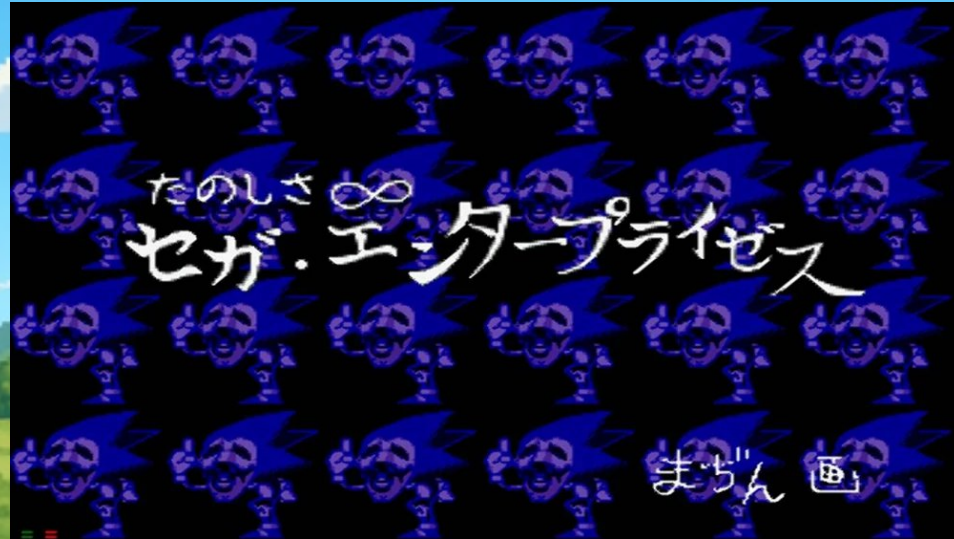
Spring Mine Drops:

	Jewels Floor Levels
Agate	All floors except 50, 100, 150, and 200
Alexandrite	Floors 50, 100, 150, 200, 251 and below
Amethyst	All floors except 50, 100, 150, and 200
Diamond	Floors that end in 0 (10, 20, 30, 40, etc.), 200+
Emerald	Floors that end in 5 (5, 15, 25, 35, etc.), 200+
Flourite	All floors except 50, 100, 150, and 200
Kappa Jewels	Floors 0, 40, 60, 80, 120, 140, 160, 180, and 255
Gem of the Kappa	Receive from Kappa after collecting all 9 jewels
Moon Stone	Floors that end in 8 (8, 18, 28, 38, etc.)
Peridot	All floors except 50, 100, 150, and 200
Pink Diamond	Floors 30, 70, 90, 110, 130, 170, 190, 255
Ruby	All floors except 50, 100, 150, and 200
Sand Rose	Floors that end in 9 (9, 19, 29, 39, etc.)
Topaz	All floors except 50, 100, 150, and 200
Black Grass	Any floor

Lake Mine Drops:

	Ore Floor Levels
Adamantite	Floor 10 and below
Copper	All floors
Teleport Stone	Floor 255, only after 3rd year
Recipe	How to cook French Fries, Floor 255
Goddess Jewel	Floors 60, 102, 123, 152, 155, 171, 190, 202, and 222
Gem of the Goddess	Receive after collecting 9 Goddess Jewels
Gold	Level 3 and below
Mystrile	Floor 5 and below
Orichalc	Floor 10 and below
Power Berry	Floor 100
Mythic Stones	Floor 60, 102, 123, 152, 155, 171, 190, 202, and 222
Silver	All floors
Black Grass	Floors 1 to 100
